Board Reports:

- Secretary's Report – Steve
 - Sign-up numbers:

 - New Fun Ball 2
 - Volunteers Only 15
- Commissioner's Report – Ken
 - Seven dozen balls will be picked up tomorrow (3/27). Already have six dozen.
 - One fan and one cracked seat at Del Web Field have been fixed.
 - The traction treads on the stairs to the scoreboard room will be replaced.
 - A problem with the misting was found and it will be fixed.
- Treasurer's Report – Phil
 - There is \$16,425 in the checking account
 - \$3,000 in donations has or will be presented to the three Lincoln high schools. Checks have been presented to Lincoln High and Twelve Bridges High. Phoenix High is scheduled for tomorrow (3/27).
 - \$155 was spent on the parking permit and \$760 on softballs.
- Second VP's Report – Ernie
 - Only one of four scheduled clinics were held in March due to inclement weather.
 - Twenty-four players were rated, 20 new players and four which were returning after sitting out a few seasons.
 - Saturday morning practices are underway and will continue.
- First VP's Report - Joe
 - The playing schedules are complete.
 - Hot Dog Days
 - The goal for hot dog sales this year is 2,000.
 - The first Hot Dog Day will be April 7-8 at the pickle ball tournament.
 - We will stay with Costo's sesame buns.

- There is a new batting cage in the area – D-Bat in Rocklin.
- We will hold a Maintenance Appreciation Day.
 - Joe will manage a team that will face the Lincoln Hills maintenance employees.
 - Managers and a handful of players Joe will select a handful of players to fill out the roster.
 - Pizza and water will be provided for both teams
 - Game will be May 2 at 11 a.m.
- Joe arranged for Karl H to work with Ken on the functionality of the field sprinklers. This is to help ensure that the infield receives enough water to maintain quality playing conditions.

General Discussion

- Pete updated the sponsor status.
 - We have 34 sponsors and 37 sponsorships compared to 29 and 32 last year.
 - Six are new sponsors.
 - We will have a Placer Protect banner on the outfield fence this year. Placer Protect is an aid to senior in the community.
 - Starbucks on Ferrari Ranch Road near Groveland Lane will provide two coffee containers for Opening Day
- Volunteer requests will be forthcoming, including one coming out Monday (3/30) for the first Hot Dog Day. It was also noted that the \$3,000 contribution to the high schools comes from Hot Dog Day sales.
- Ken reported that the sunscreens to protect the stands will be coming.
- Banners on the outfield fence will be going up April 8.
