Board Reports:

- Secretary's Report – Steve
 - Sign-up numbers:

 - Fall Ball 5
 - Final day for sign-ups is February 18.
- Second VP's Report – Ernie
 - The conditioning clinic is underway and will continue – weather permitting – on Wednesday's at 9 a.m. for the rest of the month. About 35 showed up at the first clinic on February 4.
 - The new players assessment session will be February 21st at 9 a.m.
 - Saturday group practices will be every Saturday at 9 a.m. throughout the season. First practice is Saturday, February 28.
 - The draft will be March 4.
- Treasurer's Report – Phil
 - There is \$44,520 in the various accounts split about evenly between CDs and checking/money market accounts.
 - One CD matured in January and was renewed for six months at 3.35% interest.
 - The second CD matures in two weeks and a similar interest rate will be pursued.
- First VP's Report
